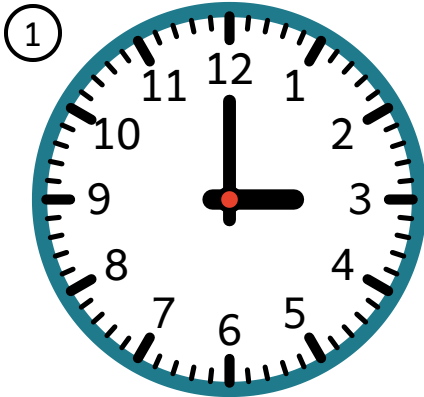
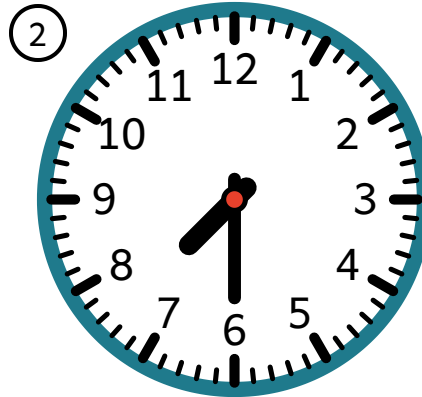

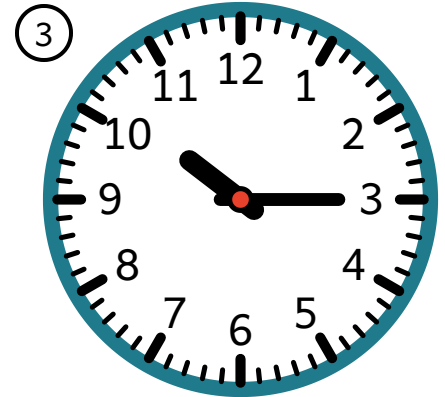
Read each clock and write its time in the box. Then draw the hands on clocks A and B.



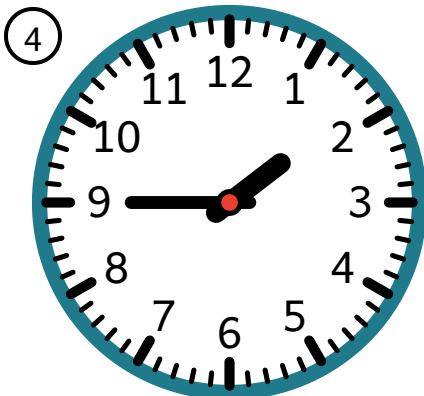

Draw 6:30

Ray says: The short hand tells the hour. The long hand counts minutes: count by fives from the 12.



Draw 2:45

For grown-ups: clocks 1-2 are hour and half-hour, 3-4 are quarter hours, 5-6 are five-minute times. Ask "which number did the short hand pass last?" before every answer. On the draw clocks, the short hand should sit past the hour, not on it. **Answers:** 1 > 3:00 · 2 > 7:30 · 3 > 10:15 · 4 > 1:45 · 5 > 4:20 · 6 > 8:50 · A > long hand on 6, short hand halfway between 6 and 7 · B > long hand on 9, short hand almost at 3
