- Draw a **plant** at **E5**.
- The **bookshelf** is at **F4**.
- The **window** is in the top row, column F.
- Put the **toy box** two squares to the right of the bed.
- Draw the **cat** one square below the rug.

What is under the **toy box**? _____

Ray says: Letter first, then number: go ACROSS to the letter, then UP or DOWN to the number.

For grown-ups: row 1 is the top row. Have them trace the letter column with one finger and the number row with the other, and meet in the middle — that crossing is what a coordinate is. For clues 5 and 6, find the starting square first. **Answers:** 1 > lamp A1 · 2 > plant E5 · 3 > bookshelf F4 · 4 > window F1 · 5 > toy box D2 (bed B2, two right) · 6 > cat D4 (rug D3, one down) · the cat > D4 · under the toy box (D2) > the rug at D3
