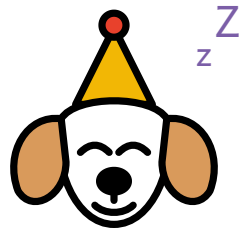

If a child stalls, run the alphabet in front of the ending: b-at, c-at, f-at. **Example answers:** cat > bat, hat > frog > log, dog > cake > lake, bake > rain > train, brain > light > night, kite > king > ring, sing > Poem > mat, cake, train, light
